A short walk away are various activities:- Horton Park Children's Farm, "Equus" Equestrian Centre for pony trekking and Horton Park Country Club with a public golf course and a driving range.

Epsom Town Centre is a 10 minute journey by car or bus, with an Odeon cinema and the Playhouse theatre. Local swimming pools are in Epsom, Banstead, Leatherhead and Kingston.



Nearby, within walking distance, is Chessington World of Adventures, with many rides and a small zoo.

Little Acres campsite is set in nearly two acres of open grassland surrounded by 400 acres of park and woodland in the scenic location of Horton Country Park. The site is available for camping, activities, night hikes, cook-outs, picnics, meetings etc.

Facilities:

- [Three flushing toilets which include a disabled facility
- [Hot and cold shower and basins
- [Running water on site
- [Eight ground level patrol fireplaces
- [Campfire circle, including a large fireplace
- [Quiet paved area with walled seating along edges
- [Four large barbecues with folding stands
- [Licensed to camp up to sixty people.

Access:

The Country Park has a large car park, a field away from the site and direct access is available for loading, unloading and parking for leaders.

Transport, Car Parking and Provisions:

Epsom is served by London trains from Victoria and Waterloo, whilst Chessington trains run to Waterloo. You can also reach the south coast from Epsom station by changing at Horsham, or by going direct from Surbiton. Buses run from nearby Horton Lane to both Kingston and Epsom.

The Country Park has a large car park, a field away from the site with a connecting footpath. Direct site access is available for loading, unloading and parking for leaders.

For provisions, Epsom has a large Sainsbury's on the edge of town, as well as Waitrose and Marks & Spencer in the town centre. Kingston has several supermarkets and a wide range of shops.

Fees:

The cost of staying at the campsite is £3 per person per night. For day visitors, the cost is £1 per person.

Deposit: £25 per booking (non-refundable).
